
DAY 01 : RIO DE JANEIRO (BRAZIL) (Dinner)

Arrivals from various locations to Rio De Janeiro.

Transfer Rio de Janeiro Airport Private services with English Speaking Guide Reception and assistance by guide with identification sign at Rio de Janeiro Int'l Airport. Transfer to hotel.

Rio de Janeiro is a huge seaside city in Brazil, famed for its Copacabana and Ipanema beaches, 38m Christ the Redeemer statue atop Mount Corcovado and for Sugarloaf Mountain, a granite peak with cable cars to its summit. The city is also known for its sprawling favelas (shanty towns). Its raucous Carnaval festival, featuring parade floats, flamboyant costumes and samba dancers, is considered the world's largest.

Dinner Overnight at Hotel.



Day 02 : RIO DE JANEIRO (BRAZIL) (Breakfast , Lunch , Dinner)

After Brekfast Depart from the hotel to visit the Christ Statue, recently elected as one of the seven modern wonders of the world. The statue sits 2,300 ft. above sea level, atop Corcovado Hill. Following a scenic drive along the Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon, we will arrive at the foot of the hill, where we embark on a small train which climbs the beautiful mountainside. Upon reaching the top, visitors will experience a panoramic view of Rio de Janeiroand discover why it is known as the "Marvelous City"! The tour also includes a drive along Rio's famous beaches.

Rio by Night with Plataforma 1 Show A spectacular samba show with singers and dancers in elaborate costumes who present Brazil's rich folkloric traditions and capture the famous rhythms of Carnaval.

Dinner overnight at Hotel.



Day 03 : RIO DE JANERIO (BRAZIL) (Breakfast , Lunch , Dinner)

Depart from the hotel passing by the beaches of São Conrado, Leblon, Ipanema, Copacabana, Leme, and Urca.

Then you will visit el Pan de Azúcar (Sugar Loaf), at 395 meters above sea level, a mountain located in the middle of Guanabara Bay. The ascent is made in two stages to arrive at the peak: first, you take a cable car which leads to morro de Urca, where you are lowered to another cable car that goes up to the Morro Pão de Açúcar. From there you can see some of the historical sites of the city, including the Cathedral and the Municipal Theatre. It is a wonderful, unforgettable panoramic view. After the tour, return to the hotel.

Dinner overnight at Hotel.





Day 04: RIO DE JANERIO – IGUASSU (BRAZIL – ARGENTINA) (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Transfer from hotel to Rio de Janeiro Int'l Airport for flight to Iguassu. Then onwards we shall take the flight to Iguassu upon arrival transfer to Hotel on the Argentina Side of the falls.

Dinner and overnight at Hotel.



Day 05 : IGUASSU ARGENTINA SIDE OF FALLS (ARGENTINA) (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Excursion Argentine side of the Falls Seat in Coach Service with English Guide - Full Day

Depart from the hotel crossing the bridges Tancredo Neves and Juan D. Perón that join the Argentine city of Puerto Iguazu (Argentina) y Foz de Iguazu (Brasil) to visit the Argentine side of the Iguazu Falls, located within the Iguazu National Park. With an extension of 67.000 hectares the park has been declared a Natural Patrimony of Humanity by the UNESCO. The Falls are integrated by 275 waterfalls that fall from an average altitude of seventy meters. The starting point is the "Central Station", from whichvisitors can chooseto take the train that goes to "Falls Station" or the one that goes to "Devil's ThroatStation". From these points it is possible carry out diverse excursions:

The superior walk is a walk of 800 meters on footbridges, elevated over the surface of the terrain so as not to obstruct or drive away/frighten the fauna. On this walk, visitors can observe the waterfalls

from the upper part of the Dos Hermanas, Bosetti, Bernabé Méndez, M'Bigua falls, among others. It lasts for an hour and the range of difficulty is low, there are no stairs.

The inferior walk is a 1,600 meters walk on footbridges elevated over the surface of the terrain, where visitors can see the two sisters, Alvar Nuñez, San Martín, and Bosetti falls and the Rock de la Bella Vista.Visitors can alsohave a panoramic view of the Devil's Throatand the Río Iguazu Inferior Canyon. This walk lasts for two hours and the range of difficulty is moderate, with stairs. Besides, in this circuit (and with Seat in Coach services) a visit to the Isla San Martín can be performed and go aboard for the "The Great Ad venture" excursion. This tour is optional.The excursion Devil's Throat starts at the "Devil's Throat Station" to go walking through the footbridges for about 1,200 meters which allow the visitor to enjoy the view of the most important waterfall of the Falls. The excursion lasts two hours, and the range of difficulty is low, there are no stairs. The return is done by train up to the Visitors Center. Once the excursion ends, return to the Entrance Fee Included to Argetinean National Park. **Dinner overnight at Hotel.**



Day 06 : IGUASSU BRAZIL SIDE OF FALLS (BRAZIL) (Breakfast , Lunch , Dinner)

Depart Hotel towards the National Park do Iguaçu, one of the biggest vegetation reservation in Brazil, until arriving at the visitors' center. Here, passengers will take a bus that will take them on a tour inside the park and then to the beginning of the footbridges placed over the cliffs of the Iguazu River. The length of these footbridges extends to almost a kilometer. During the walk it is possible to get a panoramic view of the Isla San Martín and of the most majestic waterfalls: the Bossetti, the San Martín and the Three Musketeers. Towards the end of the walk is the view point, from which you can appreciate a unique view of the Devil's Throat, which, at this point, is only about 150 meters away.

This wonderful view is even more enhanced by the constant formation of rainbows. The itinerary ends next to the Salto Floriano waterfall where there is a small store and there is access to the panoramic elevator, which visitors can take if they wish to. At the end of the walk there is a long stairway which leads to the place from which visitors get their transfer back to the hotel. The daily tours are preferably done in the mornings due to the position of the sun over the waterfalls. **Dinner overnight at Hotel.**



Day 07: BUENOS AIRES - CITY TOUR AND RECOLETA CEMETRY(ARGENTINA) (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

The city of Buenos Aires is the capital of the Republic of Argentina.. This cosmopolitan city, is the birthplace of the tango, with a varied cuisine and a fascinating European architecture. Buenos Aires offers a varied cultural life. It offers museums, theatres, monuments, libraries, entertainment and sports activities. The city although it spans many styles, Buenos Aires has a personality that completely captures the newcomers. You can find objects and garments more sophisticated and, at night, restaurants and night clubs where they stay awake until the early hours of the morning. The tour heads first to Plaza de Mayo, historical and political core of the city, to discover its main buildings and monuments: the Pirámide de Mayo, the Casa Rosada (Presidential Palace), the colonial Cabildo and the Metropolitan Cathedral. We continue along Avenida de Mayo, interesting for its different architectural styles, to reach 9 de Julio Avenue, with its eight lanes embellished with lawns, fountains and sculptures, and of course the Obelisco, undisputable emblem and gravitational center of the city. From here the tour travels back in time to San Telmo, the oldest districts in the city, where each Sunday an antiques' market takes place, and which boasts an attracting night vibe with gourmet restaurants, lively bars and, of course, the "tanguerias" (restaurants with live tango). Moving on southwards, we reach the picturesque port district of La Boca, with its famous alley Caminito whose colored tin houses and customs reflect the influence of the 19th century European immigrants in the typical "cantinas" (small restaurants) and "conventillos" (tenement houses). The visit continues to Puerto Madero, with its old port warehouses turned into offices, apartments, world-class restaurants and bars, with an amazing view of the docks and the Rio de la Plata. Finally, we continue to the residential neighborhood of Palermo with its elegant mansions and ample parks, to end at La Recoleta, where there are remarkable sights such as the church of Nuestra Señora del Pilar, the Cultural Center and the circular building of the Palais de Glace. We will visit the cemetery, surprising for its rich architecture, for its suggestive stories and the relevant historic figures buried there, among whom Evita is probably the most renowned. Return to hotel.

Day 07 : LIMA (PERU) (Brekfast , Lunch , Dinner)

City tour and Larco Museum.

Seat in Coach with English Guide - Half Day

We will drive along the main streets, plazas and avenues of the city. We will start at the Lovers Park in Miraflores with a spectacular view of the Pacific Ocean. Then, we will have a panoramic view of Huaca Pucllana, a ceremonial center the ancient Lima culture; and in San Isidro, the financial center of the city, we will see Huaca Huallamarca, an ancient pre-Inca shrine. We will then continue to the Main Square, where we will find the Government Palace and the City Hall.





We will visit the Cathedral and walk to Saint Francis, a convent of the 17th century, where we will be able to visit the famous catacombs. Finally, the Larco Museum will be awaiting us. This is a mansion built on top of a pre- Columbian pyramid of the 7th century. There we will find treasures that have been exhibited in the most prestigious museums of the world and it is organized according to techniques. The storeroom and the unique display of erotic pottery of pre-Columbian times are the highlights.

Dinner overnight at Hotel.

Day 08 : LIMA – CUZCO (PERU) (Breakfast , Lunch , Dinner)

Transfer from hotel to Lima Airport Upon arrival at Cuzco transfer to Hotel City Tour and Archaeological Park We will climb up the Archeological Park of Sacsayhuaman, and start our excursion visiting the fortress with the same name, a beautiful place that radiates peace and quiet, where we will be able to admire the huge rocks measuring up to 4 meters high that were used in its construction. We will then head for Q'enqo, and ancient temple of the Puma, where we will be able to appreciate an altar for sacrifices in the inner part of a huge rock, and then Tambomachay, sacred fountains of life and health. On the way we will have a panoramic view from Puca Pucara, a watchtower that controlled the entrance to the city. After that we will visit the Temple of the Sun "The Korikancha", on top of which the Saint Dominique Convent was built. A legend tells that his temple was entirely lined in gold sheets that marveled the Conquistadors upon their arrival. Finally, we will go to the Main Square and will visit the Cathedral that reassures invaluable colonial paintings and other works of art such as the Cross that arrived with the first conquistadors.






Day 09: SACRED VALLEY (CUZCO) (PERU) (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Market, Ollantaytambo Fortres

You will start your tour in Awanakancha, an exhibition center of textilesand South Americancamelids located at kilometer 23 of the road to Pisac. It is considered a living museum and here you can see Andean camelids, learn about the techniques to take their wool and finally acquire finely spun garments. You wil then visit the Pisac market, consisting of dozens of stalls displaying and selling goods crafted by residents of the area. You can find textiles, carvings, and replicas of ancient Inca pieces. Located 33 kilometers from the city of Cusco, it is a town built as a partridge, also known for hosting one of the most important archaeological sites in the Sacred Valley on the slopes of the hills. It is perhapsthe largest complexof platforms in the area. Free time to visit the area on your own. Once you finish the tour, the guide will recommend a place to enjoy lunch and in the afternoon return to Cusco. Dinner Overnight at hotel.



Day 10 : SACRED VALLEY MACHU PICHU SACRED VALLEY (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

We will wake up early in the morning to enjoy our breakfast and then we will start a fascinating journey to one of the Seven Wonders of the World. You will be taken to the train station for a fascinating 1 hour and a half (approximately) train journey (Vista Dome train service) to Aguas Calientes town, where the famous citadel of Machu Picchu is. When we arrive to Aguas Calientes town, which is located in the province of Urubamba, at an altitude of 2,400 masl, we will take a 25minute bus drive of winding road, to "The Lost City of the Incas.Once there, we will have a guided tour to The Historical Sanctuary of

Machu Picchu and visit the Main Plaza, the Circular Tower, the Sacred Sun Clock, the Royal Quarters, the Temple of the Three Windows and various burial grounds. After the tour, we will have time to stroll around the Archaeological Site at leisure. After we are done with our tour, we will return to Cusco in the Vistadome train. Upon your arrival to Cusco you will be transferred to your selected hotel.

You will have the evening to enjoy Cusco at your leisure.


Day 11 : CUZCO – SANTIAGO (PERU – CHILE) (Breakfast , Lunch , Dinner)

Transfer to airport for your flight to Santiago.,

Upon Arrival we shall make a panoramic city tour of Santiago

Depart from the hotel to explore the main streets of the civic district of the city of Santiago of Chile, seeing the way the Cerro Santa Lucia, the Palacio de la Moneda and the Plaza de Armas, around which are the Cathedral, the national historical Museum and the Central post. It continues to forest park and the Museum of fine arts, to the bohemian neighborhood of Bellavista. Private service includes the visit to the Cerro San Cristóbal, while in regular service, access to the Cerro Santa Lucia. After the excursion, return to the hotel.

Dinner and overnight at Hotel.



Day 12 : SANTIAGO VINA DEL MAR AND WINE TASTING (CHILE) (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Depart from the hotel toward the Pacific Ocean across from the Casablanca Valley, known for its vineyards. At one of these vineyards, there will be a tasting. This activity is exclusively in private service. Arriving at the coast, visit the beaches and the city of Vina del Mar, with its beautiful parks and ornamental flowers. Continue toward the picturesque port of Valparaíso,founded in the 16th Century. Thanks to its singular architecture, it was declared a World Patrimony site by UNESCO in 2003. The city is situated among various hills, which lead through alleyways, long stariways and diverse elevators constructed between the end of the 19th and early 20th centuries. Optional tour of the Mueum of Pablo Neruda, La Sebastiana. The entrance to the museum is included in private services. At the end of the tour, return to Santiago to arrive finally at the hotel.



Day 13 : SANTIAGO - PUERTO MONTT - PUERTO VARAS (CHILE) (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Transfer to Airport for flight to Puerto Montt Upon arrival transfer to Puerto Varas, Puerto varas : Puerto Varas is a city in southern Chile's Lake District. It sits on the southwest banks of the expansive Lake Llanquihue, which offers commanding views of snow-capped Osorno Volcano and Calbuco Volcano, both still active. Traditional German-style architecture characterizes the town, reflecting its colonial past. Built in the early 20th century, the red-and-white Sacred Heart of Jesus Church has 3 striking towers. **Transfer to hotel check in and rest of the day at leisure to enjoy the beautiful lake side city. Puerto varas**

Day 14 : PUERTO VARAS (Breakfast , Lunch , Dinner)

Visit Osorno Volcano up-close with this half day tour from Puerto Varas! The road to the volcano borders the Llanquihue Lake and offers a unique and picturesque landscape. As we reach the base of the volcano, we will take a zigzag route to get to one of the craters where we can see its depth. Once at the chairlift station, we will get to the top of the volcano, from where we can stunning views of enjoy the Llanquihue Lake and the surrounding areas. Dinner overnight at hotel.



Day 15 : PUNTA ARENAS - PUERTO NATALES (CHILE) (3 Hours driving) (Breakfast , Lunch , Dinner)

Transfer to Airport for your flight to Punta Arenas Upon Arrival we shall drive to Puerto Natales Arrive and Dinner overnight at Hotel.

Day 16 : PUERTO NATALES TORRES DEL PAINE NATIONAL PARK – PUERTO NATALES FD TORRES DEL PAINE (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Depart from the hotel to the Torres del Paine National Park, of 242,242 hectares, which was declared a World Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 1978. The impressive Andean massif, whose summits have an impact on everyone who visits the Park, is surrounded by glaciers such as the Grey, and waterfalls, lagoons and lakes like the Pehoé. All of these together with the varied flora and fauna make this place one of the most renowned in the world for its richness and natural beauty. Returning to Puerto Natales, you will stop at the Milodon Cave, a natural monument, in which there are found remains of a prehistoric animal. After the excursion, you return to the hotel. Day 17 : TORRES DEL PAINE – CANCHA CARRERA (CHILE ARGENTINA BORDER CROSSING) – EL CALAFATE – (CHILE –ARGENTINA) (TIME DRIVING 8 HOURS IN TOTAL) (Breakfast – Lunch – Dinner)

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

This morning we shall drive onto the Famous City of El Calafate to view the Magnificient Glaciers

Glacierium : Arriving from El Calafate we see a building appearing on the horizon. Its architecture represents the front of the glacier, which is the predominant view of the steppe. Lands that glaciers covered thousands of years ago, and where you can still see traces. Two pavilions house the exhibit with the most modern museology resources. You enter through a dark corridor, guided by the pleasant sound of water dripping down from the melting ice. Then the surprise begins as the ice panels begin to speak of the formation of the ice, the story of explorers and scientists. Pictures of great Argentinean photographers such as Florian Von der Flecht, Daniel Wagner, and Andrés Bonetti catch your eye and help your imagination. First the beginning of the universe, the glacial periods. Further down is a large model of the ice field, the origin of the glacial period that you will see during your visit to the area. Interactive screens allow you to view, for example, the recoil of the Upsala glacier.

An important tribute to the great Francisco Pascasio Moreno makes it seem as though he is there inspiring us with his enthusiasm for the Argentinean landscapes. Also part of the visit is a unique connection with the Perito Moreno Glacier, which forms a natural dam that then collapses with a great break. The tour ends in a tunnel with an interesting system of simultaneous projections that awakens your senses. Now you are put on red alert for you are faced with the fact that global warming is accelerating and threatening the planet. This is all part of the legacy that you will take along from your visit to the Glaciarium

Dinner overnight at hotel.



Day 18 : EL CALAFATE (ARGENTINA) - Upsala Glacier (Breakfast , Lunch , Dinner)

Depart from the hotel towards Punta Bandera, located 50 km. from El Calafate. Board a catamaran to sail the Brazo Norte of the Argentino Lake towards the Upsala Glaciar, crossing the impressive barrier of ice floes that break off constantly, from the front of the Upsala Glacier, reaching 800 meters deep in the lake. Continue sailing towards the Spegazzini channel to see the glaciers Seco, Heim south, and the imposing Spegazzini that stands out for being the highest in the National Park at 110 meters above sea level, and by the particularity that there are no signs of regression. Return to the harbor around 2:00pm, and then transfer to the hotel. **Dinner overnight at hotel**.

Day 19 : EL CALAFATE – PERITO MORENO – EL CALAFATE (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Depart from the hotel toward the Perito Moreno Glacier, located in the Glacier National Park 80 km. from the city of Calafate. From the beginning the tour offers pleasant surprises. Upon leaving the city, along the right side of the road, you can see Lake Argentino with Redonda Bay, which offers an interesting variety of bird life. During the first 50 kms, the direction follows across the Patagonian steppe. At the entrance to the National Park there is a drastic change in the vegetation which is rich in the special types of trees found in the Patagonian Andes: especially ñires, lengas and cherry trees, among others. The glacier is an impressive river of ice with a surface of 257 square Kms., a length of 30 kms. and a width of four kms. The height of the front wall ranges between 50 and 60 meters above the level of the lake. In the central part of the glacier, the ice has a depth of between 250 and 350 meters. This frozen river descends from the continental ice field and causes in its slow progress landslides and explosions that make the glacier a wonder in constant motion. It is a show that impresses not only by its visual beauty, but also by the constant roar you hear from inside it, which has caused it to be declared a World Heritage Site. During the tour a walk along the paths on the front of the glacier allow a view of this impressive natural marvel from a different perspective. At the end of the tour, begin the return to Calafate to arrive at the hotel.

Nautical Safari : This tour offers the possibility of observing with a completely different perspective the impressive walls south of the Perito Moreno Glacier and its continuous landslide into the waters of the Rico arm. Boarding takes place in the port located in the Bay Bajo de las Sombras(Under the Shadows), approximately six kilometers from the glacier lookout. Coming up to the south end of the Rico Arm the ship is approximately 300 meters from the wall of the glacier, which allows a tour and view of the entire area.

Day 20 : EL CALAFATE - BUENOS AIRIES (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Transfer to Airport for flight to Buenos Aries Seat in Coach Service with English Speaking Guide Arrive Transfer to Hotel . Dinner Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 21 : BUENOS AIRIES (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Full Day City tour northern zone and residential areas & Southern Zone and Historical Highlights The tour begins in the area of Recoleta, one of the most sophisticated and desirable areas of Buenos Aires, where some of the best resturuants, cafes, nightclubs and shops are found. The name comes from the Order of Shoeless Recoletas Monks, who established their monastery there at the beginning of the 17th Century, their church, and a small churchyard, which are the heart of the neighborhood. The Cemetery of Recoleta (the old churchyard), delights visitors with its location, its rich architecture and the social and political personalities of Argentina whose remains are there, one of the most distinguished being Eva Peron. Alongside the cemetery is the Church of Our Lady of Pilar and the Cultural Center of Recoleta (former monastery), important for its contemporary artisitic manifestations. In the rear part of this building is located Buenos Aires Design, a commercial center exclusively for decorators and interior designers. Another traditional building in Recoleta is the Palais de Glace. Of cylindrical shape, it was originally an ice-skating rink. In 1920 it was converted into an aristocratic setting for the tango, that for the first time abandoned the brothels of the lower classes to rise up to high society. Today this same building is used as a center for temporary exhibitions. This entire group of buildings,(composed of the cemetery, church, and the commercial and exposition center, are surrounded by peaceful park space filled with 100 year old trees,) known as Plaza San Martin de Tours, Plaza Francia, and the modern Carlos Thays Park, created just a few years ago in a space previously used as an amusement park. Leaving Recoleta, the tour continues to the North toward the residential neighborhood of Palermo with its elegant mansions surrounded by green lawns where one finds the National Library, the Faculty of the Law University of Buenos Aires, the Latinamerican Museum of Art of Buenos Aires (MALBA) and the Parque 3 de Febrero, which is composed of the Rosedal, Japanese Garden, the Botanical Garden, the Zoo and the Planetarium. Here the tour ends and begin the return towards the hotel.

world for its exceptional acoustics. Returning toward the south one arrives at the picturesque and colorful port neighborhood of La Boca, with its famous street "Caminito" whose buildings and customs reflect the influence of European settlers that arrived at its shores during the XIX century and left their imprint not only in the multicolor houses still being used today but also in the cuisine of the typical"cantinas," small restaurants. La Boca is also the cradle of great Argentinian soccer, as here the mythical teams of River Plate and Boca Juniors rose, the latter wi th its famous stadium La Bombonera located in this area. The tour continues past the neighborhood of San Telmo, one of the oldest areas of the city, inhabited up to the end of the 19th century by aristocratic families. This neighborhood, where every Sunday there is an antique fair on Plaza Dorrego, has kept a great part of its architectural heritage intact. This section is also active at night where one finds various tanguerias, restaurants and bars. Followed by this comes the modern neighborhood of Puerto Madero, with its old piers converted into offices, apartments, places for entertainment and elegant restaurants, and views of Rio de la Plata. The tour ends here and the return to hotel begins.


Dinner and Tango Show at Esquina Carlos Gardel

Seat in Coach services with English Speaking Guide - Depart from hotel 20:00 - 20:30 hs

Depart from the hotel towards the southern end of the city where most of the tango places are located. The tango is the music of Buenos Aires. It originated in the 1880 ghettos which were populated by Italian and Spanish immigrants, Africans and gauchos. From this intersection rose the "Compraditos," whose songs, lyrics, and dances reflect "el duelo de cuchilleros, " or knife fights characteristic of the social ambience. The tango rose from a mix of Cuban and Spanish rhythms, some polka, and according to some, also a bit of African music.
